Which Course?

<p>Level 1 – Start Sailing This one-week course will introduce you to the basic boat handling techniques and background knowledge necessary to get started in sailing. Experience required: No previous experience required Cost: was €260 NOW €190</p>
<p>Level 2A – Basic Skills (1 week) This course is suitable for children who did level 1 last year and have been sailing regularly since. (e.g. Autumn/Spring training) By the end of this one-week course you should have the skills and knowledge necessary to rig up your boat and safely go sailing without assistance in light winds. Experience required: ISA Level 1 & 1 seasons sailing experience Cost: was €260 NOW €190</p>
<p>Level 2B – Basic Skills (2 weeks) By the end of this course you will be sailing on your own in light wind conditions without assistance from your instructor. This is the course for you if you have completed Level 1 but have not had the opportunity to sail regularly since. Experience required: ISA level 1 Cost: was €350 NOW €300</p>
<p>Level 3 – Improving Skills This two-week course will help you develop a competent, safe and practical approach to sailing your boat in moderate winds. You will also be prepared for the specialist courses ahead. Experience required: ISA Level 2 Basic Skills Certificate plus 1 season’s regular sailing. Cost: was €320 NOW €300</p>
<p>Level 4 – Advanced Boat Handling & Go Racing 1 This two-week is aimed at our more experienced dinghy sailors. The course will develop advanced boat handling and tuning skills to prepare you to sail flat out in strong winds. You will also develop boat racing skills so you will comfortably race at club and inter club level in Ireland Experience required: ISA Level 3 Improving Skills Certificate plus 1 season’s regular sailing experience Cost: was €320 NOW €300</p>
<p>Fun Sailing This two-week course is aimed at sailors who have completed ISA Level (2A in 2009) or level 2 or 3 in previous years. The focus on this course will be development of sailing skills and enjoyment of our marine environment. A small number of Kayaking sessions will be offered to participants. This is a fun level course and no ISA certificate will be given. Experience required: ISA Level 2 or 3 Certificate plus 1 seasons sailing experience or level 2A (2009) Cost: was €275 NOW €250</p>
